## Question No. 1:

We are working through the **FRAMEWORK AGREEMENT FOR THE PRODUCTION AND SUPPLY OF SELF-ADHESIVE PAPER FOR EU VISA** registered by the Buyer under No. 050/OS/2022

The company does not have ISO 14298 Management of security printing processes" or "CWA 15374 Security management system for suppliers to the security printing industry". We follow these accreditations closely and STC audited the company does online in but we do not have these certifications.

Do we assume that we can still take part in the tender? Because *in the Draft Contract, Annex 1, page 8, VIII. OTHER PROVISIONS point 3 it states:* 

3. If the Seller at the time of signature of this Framework Agreement does not prove implementation of security processes to ensure the production security integrity (transport incl.) within the performance of the subject matter of the Framework Agreement through the certificate "ISO 14298 Management of security printing processes" or "CWA 15374 Security management system for suppliers to the security printing industry", the Contracting parties mutually declare that the Security Audit was conducted before the signing of this Framework Agreement.

Therefore, do we understand correctly that Tullis Russell can still take part in the tender because you would carry out a security audit before signing this Framework agreement?

## Answer to the question No. 1:

Yes, that's correct. As stated in the Art VIII (3) of the Draft Contract:

If the Seller at the time of signature of this Framework Agreement does not prove implementation of security processes to ensure the production security integrity (transport incl.) within the performance of the subject matter of the Framework

Agreement through the certificate "ISO 14298 Management of security printing processes" or "CWA 15374 Security management system for suppliers to the security printing industry", the Contracting parties mutually declare that the Security Audit was conducted before the signing of this Framework Agreement.

This means that if the supplier does not prove implementation of security processes to ensure the production security integrity (transport incl.) through the certificate "ISO 14298 Management of security printing processes" or "CWA 15374 Security management system for suppliers to the security printing industry", the Security Audit will be conducted before the signing of this Framework Agreement by the Contracting Authority.

The Contracting Authority does not consider this explanation as alteration or supplementation of the tender documentation whose nature would demand extension of the time limit for the tender submission in accordance with Sec. 99 (2) of the Act, since the Contracting Authority does not alter the tender conditions.
