

WRITTEN REPORT OF THE CONTRACTING AUTHORITY

„Production and Supply of Self-adhesive Paper for EU Visa Production”

In accordance with the Sec. 217 of Act No. 134/2016 Coll., on public procurement, as amended (hereinafter referred to as the “Act”) the Contracting Authority has made this written report on the above-mentioned over-threshold public contract for supplies to be awarded in an open procedure by the Act.

The subject of this public contract is the Contractor’s obligation to produce and supply the Contracting Authority with self-adhesive paper for EU visa (hereinafter referred to as “**Goods**” or “**paper**”), which must

- i. meet the technical specification requirements arising from EU requirements, namely Commission Implementing Decision C (2018) 674 dated 12 February 2018 and Regulation 2017/1370 of the European Parliament and of the European Council dated 4 July 2017 (hereinafter collectively referred to as “**European Legislation**”), and further
- ii. correspond with the Contracting Authority’s technical specifications beyond the framework of European Legislation specified in Annex No. 1 to Draft Contract,

according to the Contracting Authority 's current needs, and enable the Contracting Authority to acquire ownership of the delivered Goods.
