EXPLANATION OF TENDER DOCUMENTATION V.

The Contracting Authority of the over-threshold public contract called "**Production and supply** of prelaminated card inlays with windows for ID1 cards_reissue // Výroba a dodávky předlaminátů s okénkem pro ID1 karty_opakování" being awarded in an open procedure pursuant to Act No. 134/2016 Coll., On Public Procurement, as amended (hereinafter referred to as "Act"), hereby explains the tender documentation in accordance with Sec. 98 of the Act.

Question No. 1:	Answer to the question No. 1:
 client requires to know which structure have the polycarbonate layers in prelam in the case of the use of polycarbonate layers other than Makrofol® ID layers, client requires an explicit compatibility guarantee with the Makrofol® ID layers in production process in STC What is STC? The layer doesn't need to be exactly Makrofol® right? There are 3 layers including polycarbonate layers and white layers and transparent layers. What is the difference between polycarbonate layers and white layers? As white layers are also made from polycarbonate layers? 	 The structure depends on the production process of the supplier, the required parameter is just the thickness of the prelaminated inlay, which is specified in the Technical specification (Annex No 1 of the Draft Contract). Yes, the client requires the compatibility with the Makrofol®, mainly due to the lamination process. STC = abbreviation of the Contracting Authority's name. The material of whole prelaminated inlay has to be polycarbonate (PC).
Question No. 2:	Answer to the question No. 2:
No red colour/ red printing on the prelaminated inlay with transparent windows is required. So, the Czech map shape is printed into no colour?	The shape of Czech map is the shape of the transparent window in the prelaminated inlay. The client of the Contracting Authority does not require any additional colour printing.



Question No. 3:	Answer to the question No. 3:
When delivering the products, those 3 layers must be separated for polycarbonate layers, white layers and transparent layer? Or laminated together which cannot be put into chips and antenna?	As it is specified in the Technical Specification (Annex No. 1 of the Draft Contract), the product, which should be delivered is the prelaminated inlay without any antennas or chips.
	The client of the Contracting Authority doesn't require any separate layers.

The Contracting Authority does not consider this explanation as alteration or supplementation of the tender documentation whose nature would demand extension of the time limit for the tender submission in accordance with Sec. 99 (2) of the Act, since the Contracting Authority does not alter the tender conditions.
