EXPLANATION OF TENDER DOCUMENTATION V.

<p>a) We tried to open the attached dwg file, but it was not possible. We removed the @ from the end, but still our systems couldn't handle the dwg file. Can you please provide us asap a new dwg file? * Going in more detail we would like to mention that with removing the “@” as described below we can open the file, but something is wrong with the scale: b) If we measure a distance, it is different from the values written in the drawing c) If we put in our machines, their scale does not match the scale of the layout Would you be so kind to ask you specialists to provide another copy of the file?</p>	<p>ANSWERS TO “Annex 6 - Installation Site Drawing.dwg@”:</p> <p>a) The Contracting Authority states that “@” indicates the final version of the document. In this case, i.e. a file with a suffix, it was not possible to open the file. After removing “@”, the file can be opened without any problem.</p> <p>b) The Contracting Authority does not understand the question exactly, as the dimensions correspond to what is drawn, and the dimensions are created automatically. In addition, you need to work in the “Model” tab.</p> <p>c) The space in the file is drawn in the unit of measure “m”. If your device is in a different scale, e.g. in “mm”, you need to change the scale (preferably of the device).</p>

Conclusion:

The Contracting Authority does not consider this explanation as alteration or supplementation of the tender documentation whose nature would demand extension of the time limit for the



tender submission in accordance with Sec. 99 (2) of the Act, since the Contracting Authority does not alter the tender conditions.
